General Information

Background:

The Cuyuna Rock, Gem & Mineral Society was located in Crosby, 14 miles NE of Brainerd until recently when a new clubhouse had to be found.

The name "Cuyuna" is unique because it derives from a man by the name of Cuyler Adams. Story has it that Mrs. Adams coined the name "Cuyuna" using part of Cuyler's name and that of his dog Una. Mr. Adams discovered iron ore in the area, and the Cuyuna Iron Range was established.

There is no active mining in the area at this time, but the pits have filled with water and been stocked with trout. "Locals" spend a lot of time fishing (with great success) for trout, northern pike, bass, crappies and sunfish. The mines are now part of a state park.

If you are interested, it is possible to drive to the top of one of the dumps for a bird's eye view of the Crosby area. Please e-mail Marge at marjen@crosbyironton.net if you would like more information. It's only about 3 or 4 miles from Crosby. This could probably be done sometime on the Friday before the show – depending on weather.

Previously, many rockhounds collected specimens of binghamite and silkstone from the mining dumps. It is said to be the only place binghamite is found. (Be sure to attend the meetings on May 6 – it's possible you might just be the lucky door prize winner of a specimen of binghamite or silkstone.)

The old Soo Line Railroad Depot. It is now a museum and houses, among lots of other things, a small rock collection of Cuyler Adams.

The Milford Mine is about 4 miles north of Crosby. The worst mining disaster in the State of Minnesota happened here in 1924. It is a park now.

We are hoping to be able to tour the Croft Underground Mine area. Updates on this and other possible events – field trips, etc. will appear in the Convention news articles in the upcoming MWF Newsletters. Minnesota's weather will play a part in some of the activities.

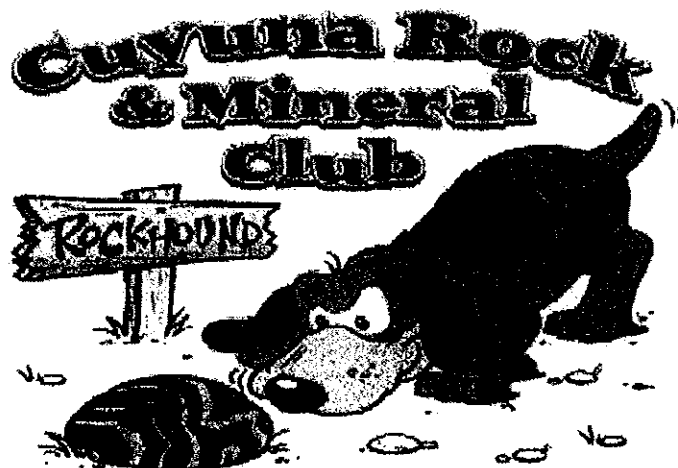

77th MWF Convention Lodging Arrangements

A block of rooms is reserved at two different locations for four nights, Thursday May 4 through Sunday May 7, for those of you who may want to remain an extra day or so and explore our area.

Super 8 Brainerd/Baxter MN, 14341 Edgewood Dr, Baxter MN 56425, 218-828-4288, is located about 3 miles from the meeting site and approximately 5 miles from the show site. The block will be held until April 4 so make your reservations early. Cost per night is \$89.88 plus tax. Complimentary breakfast served from 6:00 am to 9:30 am daily. Please ask for the block reserved by Cuyuna Rock, Gem & Mineral Society.

The Grand Casino Mille Lacs Hotel is located right on US Highway 169 about 9 miles south of Garrison. It is about 32 miles from Brainerd. The distance is farther from the show and/or meeting sites, but the amenities might interest you. The rate is \$59 for Thursday and Sunday nights and \$69 for Friday and Saturday, plus tax. No continental breakfast. However, there are a couple of restaurants on the premises. These rooms will be held until April 13, 2017. RV camping is available at the show site – Crow Wing County Fairgrounds. Electric is furnished and there is a dump station on premises. Cost is \$27 per day.
